If you are, then Age Concern may be able to help you by advising you about money that is rightfully yours.

Many people are put off by the amount of forms to fill in, Age Concern are there to provide that support and advice and to help you complete those forms.

So if you are between the ages of 55 and 65, ill or disabled and need help with personal care and/or mobility, then you may be eligible for Disability Allowance for example (free phone) 0800 88 22 00.
