### Purpose of the job:

To assist a trades employee to deliver a high quality and continuously improving Repairs Service to all the South Lakes Housings (SLH) customers whilst participating in a relevant modern apprenticeship scheme.

Whilst working within the Homes Division of SLH to develop competence to the Relevant NVQ qualification in a main trade you will also work as part of a wider team to develop skills and experience in performing tasks outside the base trade.

#### **Key accountabilities:**

- 1. Maintain punctual attendance at the agreed daily pick up point with all of the correct PPE and equipment needed.
- To assist and work under the guidance of qualified trade employees carrying out installation and repairs in all SLH managed stock developing skills and experience in an agreed base trade.
- 3. To participate in a Modern Apprenticeship Scheme, attending and successfully completing an appropriate college course relevant to the Trade as required and receiving on the job training.
- 4. To ensure all college work, logbooks etc, are kept up to date, in accordance with the apprenticeship requirements and are regularly checked by Supervisor.
- 5. To agree to undertake the necessary training and examination to gain a full UK driving licence by the end of the training period.
- 6. To ensure that a high level of service and customer care is delivered to customers of SLH and those customers receive a service in line with the policy and procedures of SLH in order to meet targets.

- 7. To use hand and electric/hydraulic machine tools and be prepared to undergo training for this.
- 8. To ensure that Health, Wellbeing and Safety policies and procedures are adhered to, to deliver effective and safe services and operations.
- 9. To ensure you work in accordance with the Equality Act 2010 and our Equality & Diversity Policy at all times.
